



PRESS RELEASE:

Full-scale exercise focused on preparing for complicated, mass casualty situations to include City of Danbury first responders and the Danbury Hospital.

June 27, 2017

Law enforcement, Fire, EMS and other emergency responders from around the region will participate in a full-scale exercise on June 27 designed to prepare for the possibility of a mass-casualty incident in the City of Danbury.

Emergency managers from the City of Danbury planned the exercise to help protect residents by preparing for an attack or other mass-casualty event.

The regional exercise will be staged St. Gregory the Great School on Great Plain Rd., with activity also occurring at Great Plain Elementary School, Broadview Middle School, and the Danbury Hospital. The drill will involve dozens of police, fire, and emergency medical service personnel and 100 volunteer actors.

There is no reason for residents to be alarmed; the exercise will occur in a controlled environment.
